

BOX OUT BULLYING CORF TEAM TRAINING COMPONENTS

Generate awareness and involvement on the part of the adults in the school

To reduce the prevalence of bullying we need a change in the climate of the school and devote time and energy in teaching the socio-emotional development of students.

SCHOOL – LEVEL COMPONENTS

Create a school based core team that will become 'resident experts' on bullying prevention

Staff and team training.

Conduct survey.

Carry out staff meetings.

Introduce rules against bullying.

Review and Enhance schools bullying prevention policy.

Involve parents.

CLASSROOM-LEVEL COMPONENTS

Make anti-bullying regulations visible

Conduct meetings with students regarding bullying prevention

Conduct meetings with parents of students.

INDIVIDUAL-LEVEL COMPONENTS

When bullying occurs, make sure that all staff intervene

Hold meetings with students involved in bullying

Hold meetings with parents of involved students

Develop individual intervention plans for involved students

COMMUNITY-LEVEL COMPONENTS

Involve community members on the Bullying Prevention Team

Develop partnerships with community members to support your schools program.

Help to spread anti-bullying messages and principles of best practice in the community
