Box Out Bullying Afterschool Residency

Using creative drama, Box Out Bullying teaches social and emotional skills to young people to create positive learning environments. A school climate assessment is conducted at the start of each residency to identify the particular challenges that the community is facing. The residency is evaluated throughout its duration and all workshops are taught by two highly trained teaching artists/drama therapists.
