



Peace Table Comprehension Checklist

- ❑ There is a complete Peace Table in place.
 - Refer to Peace Table Setup Checklist
- ❑ Students and teachers know that peace tables are used for two things:
 - Quiet self reflection
 - To invite others to solve potential conflicts or concerns facing students
- ❑ Teacher has established a time during the day when a peace table can be used
- ❑ Students are able to model “I” statements
- ❑ Students know the order of operation while at the Peace Table.
- ❑ The person that did the inviting knows they need to start the timer.
- ❑ The person that did the inviting is able to begin with an “I-statement”
- ❑ Both participants at the peace table have been able to use a peaceful tone when at the peace table.
- ❑ After three minutes, if the students haven’t been able to come up with a resolution, students know they must leave the peace table and return to what they were doing.
 - They can return to the peace table another day.
- ❑ Students have been using the peace table
