



BULLYING



"Bullying is when a student hurts or frightens someone else on purpose, again and again, and that other student who is being bullied cannot easily defend themselves."



"Bullying is when someone does something mean to someone else many, many times." BULLYING OCCURS WHEN ALL THREE ELEMENTS ARE PRESENT Intentionality

Repetition

Unequal Power

BULLYING EXAMPLE



Bullying is when someone, hurts or frightens another person <u>on</u> <u>purpose</u>, <u>again and again</u>, and that <u>person cannot easily defend</u> <u>themselves</u>.

Share your concerns with your child's teacher, counselor, and principal.


